

3 – Good Health and Well-Being

AKKC has chosen two targets to show special consideration:

3.3 - By 2030, end the epidemics of AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria and neglected tropical diseases and combat hepatitis, water-borne diseases and other communicable diseases.

AKKC is determined to take the required precautions to avoid spread of diseases when handling and administrating events. The efforts include informing customers and visitors on the guidelines within the organization, ensuring the possibility of proper spacing, using UVC-lighting to kill bacteria on technical equipment (i.e. headsets and microphones), and access to hand sanitization, hand sanitizer and face masks.

Besides the precautions taken to protect our visitors, AKKC has also introduced several safety measures to stop the spread of diseases within our staff. In addition to natural attention to hand sanitization, these efforts also include making it possible to keep a safe distance between staff, the possibility of working from home, the preparation of emergency work units, sending home symptom-showing staff, etc.

3.4 - By 2030, reduce by one third premature mortality from non-communicable diseases through prevention and treatment and promote mental health and well-being.

AKKC wants to secure a positive workplace for the organization's staff. This is realized by giving priority to, and accommodating, staff demands and desires. Thus, ensuring the best prerequisites for problem solving and general comfort in the workplace.
