

13 - Climate Action

AKKC has chosen three targets to show special consideration:

13.1 - Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards and natural disasters in all countries.

AKKC is continuously taking initiatives to reduce the organization's CO₂-imprint. Specific actions includes replacing present lighting with LED-lights, energy optimization, furthering sustainable purchases, and sorting waste.

Furthermore, AKKC contributes by the development of CO₂ accounting, using the account as a guiding tool to further limit the organization's CO₂-emission. AKKC also invests in wind power.

13.2 - Integrate climate change measures into national policies, strategies and planning.

AKKC is determined to enter partnerships that will advance sustainable development in Aalborg. An example of the organization's involvement shows in its work towards promoting Aalborg and Northern Jutland as a sustainable destination. This work is carried out in partnership with local actors involved in tourism, Aalborg Municipality, and the local business environment.

13.3 - Improve education, awareness-raising and human and institutional capacity on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction and early warning.

AKKC has extensive reach to a variety of stakeholders. The organization utilizes said reach to promote the sustainable agenda. This pool of stakeholders includes everything from citizens, suppliers, sponsors, partners, the public, the political environment, the business environment, knowledge institutions, media, etc.

Through these forums, AKKC informs on its sustainable efforts while encouraging stakeholders to make their own contribution to the sustainable development.
